- Administer first aid to a casualty that is suffering from shock;

- Delegates should be able to help a casualty suffering from:
 - A seizure
 - Heart attack (with deliberator training)
 - Anaphylactic shock (practice with a EpiPen)
 - Diabetic emergency
 - Stroke
 - Allergic reactions
- Delegates should be about to confidently help some who is:
 - Choking
 - Bleeding
 - Burns
 - Head Injuries
 - Joint injuries
 - And much more
